context information exchanged contains..."

Alex Malek: Per Ravi's comments: "The task context information exchanged contains a potentialOwners element, which can be used at task creation time to override the set of task assignments that we defined in the original task definition. Compliant implementations MUST allow overriding of simple tasks and routing patterns that are a singlelevel deep, i.e. routing patterns that dont have nested routing patterns. If the task context potentialOwners contains a list of htt:user and htt:group, and the task definition contains a routing pattern element htt:arallel or htt:sequence that has as its only children htt:user and htt:group elements, the WS-HumanTask Processor MUST replace the list in the task definition with the list in the task context. If the task definition contains only a list of htt:user and htt:group, then the WS-HumanTask Processor MUST replace the list of users from the task definition with the list of users in the task context."
