

PLCS/OSLC Workshop

Increasing globalization, outsourcing and competitive pressures are driving the need for closely integrated extended enterprises for the development of complex products. This has resulted in requirements to share and integrate engineering and product data across the product life cycle. Consequently a number of standards have been developed and deployed to enable the integration of applications and product data. In particular the OASIS PLCS (Product Life Cycle Support) specification and the associated ISO 10303 set of standards and the OASIS OSLC (Open Services for Lifecycle Collaboration) specifications.

A workshop is being organized as a precursor to the 2014 PDT Europe conference with the objective of exploring how “information” standards such as PLCS and ISO 10303 and “interoperability” standards such as OSLC can complement each other by:

- investigating how and where the OASIS PLCS and OSLC standards overlap and complement each other;
- establishing how, when and where the two standards are intended to be used;

Then feeding back the results and recommendations from the workshop to the OASIS PLCS and OSLC technical committees.

The workshop facilitators are Dr Rob Bodington (Eurostep) and Gray Bachelor (IBM).
