Ashok: Suppose there is a binding and that it has alwaysProvides and mayProvides

- if you want to do something not in those, you can add in a PolicySet

Ashok: so this neverProvides marks out some things that cannot be done in that way (no policySet could be used to obtain this feature)

Dave: If a service or reference @requires="X" and the binding is used that has @neverProvides="X", then it is an error

Slide 6 - an alternative approach - using positive statements of available policies that can be configured using parameters/policy sets - ie. list those extra things that the binding does support: @provides attribute on binding type
