- In response to Mark Ford's comments regarding PRD 2 we agreed to make a number of editorial improvements as well as incorporating one additional issue (BP-144) involving a normative change. We therefore agreed that (as per OASIS process) we will conduct a third public review.
- Prior to the next TC meeting we will conduct an email ballot on the proposed resolution of BP-144. The editing team will prepare our PRD 3 candidate in parallel, and we will plan to vote on issuing PRD 3 at the next TC.

Ralf Mueller: Discussion on encoding of QNames + Org Entity for HT Advanced query operations

Ralf Mueller: Issue: Specifying complex types (like org entities) in the where clause of the query

Ralf Mueller: Proposal: QNames encoded using "{namespaceURI}localName" format, which is common practice in Java and other technologies

Ralf Mueller: Proposal: Organizational Entities are checked on the "user" or "group" level using SQL IN clause, e.g. "task.potentialOwner.user IN ('Joe', 'Fred') "

Ralf Mueller: WHERE clause needs some processing (parsing) anyway before it can be used in a SQL statement

Ralf Mueller: Michael R.: Make namespace part optional

Ralf Mueller: Continue discussion about tUser in task results vs. xsd:string

Ralf Mueller: Issue considered a pure editing issue, XML-Schema file is correct

Ralf Mueller: Next: Type of ID's not consistently defined: Editing Issue

Ralf Mueller: Next: Schema definition for Org Entities: Contradicts <http://www.osoa.org/jira/browse/BP-125>

Ralf Mueller: Mark seems to refer to old text, issue is fixed

Ralf Mueller: Next: Minor editorial suggestions, discussion about XML-Schema type tStatus

Ralf Mueller: Proposal: Leave tStatus as is

Ralf Mueller: Next: task completion conditions

Ralf Mueller: Task is meant to be top-level task (as opposed to subtasks), see

Ralf Mueller: Subtasks can use more functions than just time functions

Ralf Mueller: Issue is considered editorial

Dieter Koenig: Completion conditions of a task without subtasks MUST use only time functions.

Ralf Mueller: XML-Schema is correct, pseudo-schema in spec text needs to be modified to include NCName: Editorial

Ralf Mueller: Next: minor B4P edits, cross document references not correct, typo error: Editorial

Ralf Mueller: Proposal: Issue PRD3

Dieter Koenig: Issue: In a where-clause of simple and advanced query operations, it is underspecified how values of type xsd:QName or type htt:tOrganizationEntity must be provided.

Ralf Mueller: Ivana move to open issue with the text posted in the chat

Dieter Koenig: Proposal: as described above with the modification that the {namespace} part for QName values is optional and treated as wildcards if not specified.
