# Media Type Endpoints

## ◆ Client Sends

Accept: application/taxii+json

## ◆ Server Responds With

Content-type: application/taxii+json

## ◆ Endpoints

## ◆ Client Sends

Accept: application/stix+json

## ◆ Server Responds With

Content-type: application/stix+json OR  
Content-type: application/taxii+json

## ◆ Endpoints

API-Root/Collections/<id>/objects/<id>/

# Why

- ◆ The reason for the change in media types is because:
  - ◆ The Bundle is a “STIX” construct and not also a “TAXII” construct.
  - ◆ If there is an error it comes back as a “TAXII” construct.

# Option

- ◆ If Bundle was also defined in TAXII, then the media types would truly be just TAXII
- ◆ However, we would need to add a URL parameter so the client could tell the server which STIX versions it supported
  - ◆ `?stix_versions=2.0,2.1,2.2`
