- 3. Task requirements; this was previousy part of the machinery task.

Statement of Purpose

Statement of Purpose for this OASIS TC Open Repository (dita-specializations) as proposed [and approved by] the TC:

The repository manages the source code and supporting documentation for DITA specializations, which were added to the DITA standard during previous releases, but which, as of DITA 2.0, are no longer contained within the standard as distributed by the DITA TC. Because these specializations used to be within the standard, and are in use by some DITA users, it is felt that they should continue to be available.
