

CALL FOR PARTICIPATION 2016 CAP Implementation Workshop



The 2016 CAP Implementation Workshop, described in a flyer available [here](#) [1] will be 23-24 August, in Bangkok, Thailand. It will be held at the Asian Institute of Technology (AIT) and co-hosted by the Sahana Software Foundation.

CAP, designated as International Telecommunication Union (ITU) Recommendation X.1303, is broadly recognized internationally as the key standard to achieve the goal of all hazards, all-media public alerting.

CAP Implementation Workshops provide a forum for implementers of CAP and associated organizations to discuss how best to expand adoption of the CAP standard. There is no charge to participate and anyone interested in emergency alerting is welcome: managers, technical staff, media, etc., including commercial organizations, governments, and non-governmental organizations.

If you have CAP implementation experiences or insights to share, please let the Program Committee know that you want to give one of the presentations. As usual, presentations will be limited to 20 minutes each.

The 2016 CAP Implementation Workshop is co-sponsored by the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC), ITU, OASIS (the international standards organization that actually maintains the CAP standard), and the World Meteorological Organization (WMO).
