

Comparison of paragraph merge behavior using non-empty and empty paragraphs with change tracking disabled and enabled – Microsoft Office 2013

Paragraph-level formatting

	CT off	CT on
Non-empty preceding	Select across: No paragraph merge	Select across: Merge, preceding wins
Non-empty following	Explicit merge: Preceding wins	Explicit merge: Preceding wins
Empty preceding	Select across: No change to non-empty	Select across: No change to non-empty
Non-empty following	Explicit merge: No change to non-empty	Explicit merge: No change to non-empty
Non-empty preceding	Select across: No change to non-empty	Select across: Preceding wins
Empty following	Explicit merge: No change to non-empty	Explicit merge: Preceding wins

If change tracking is disabled, deleting a selection created across paragraphs does not merge them. This is a runtime choice that prevents users from inadvertently merging paragraphs and seeing potentially drastic and unwanted formatting changes. A subsequent delete will explicitly merge the paragraphs. If change tracking is enabled, these two steps are not separated and the entire action is preserved as a single tracked change operation.

When paragraphs are merged...

- Non-empty preceding paragraph formatting is applied to the following non-empty paragraph
- Non-empty preceding paragraph formatting...
 - is not applied to the following empty paragraph if change tracking is disabled
 - is applied to the following empty paragraph if change tracking is enabled
- Deleted empty paragraphs do not apply formatting to non-empty paragraphs

Examples of each case follow.

Run-level (character) formatting

Formatting is not merged when it is applied to runs of characters rather than an entire paragraph.
