 $April\ revenues\ include\ the\ renewal\ of\ Ride\ Report\ for\ \$25,000\ and\ a\ new\ member,\ Populus,\ for\ \$25,000.$ 

MF qualifies for the Employee Retention Credit (ERC) under the CARES Act. Eligibility is based on a decrease of 20% or more of gross proceeds vs the same quarter in 2019.

The Employee Retention Credit is a refundable tax credit against certain employment taxes equal to 70% of the qualified wages up to \$10,000 per employee (\$7,000 x 3= \$21,000) per quarter.

 $The April Operations \ Report \ includes \ an ERC \ credit \ of \$16,428 \ for \ month \ with \ the \ balance \ of \$4,572 \ expected \ to \ be \ applied \ in \ May.$ 

The ERC credit was previously slated to end on 6/30/2021 but has been extended through 12/31/2021 (potential total credit of \$84,000 for the year).
