Notes for December Operations Report:

Voluntary dues support increased in December to include: Miami Parking Authority, San Diego Assoc of Governments, and Seattle DOT. A total \$34,500 of additional funding has been raised through this new program. Total renewal revenues for the year were under budget by -\$67.5k, with the loss of Roundtrip Systems, Flow Inc and downgrade of Bird Rides. Annual renewal revenues of \$332.5k were 83% of the \$400k budget. OMF gained 3 new member in 2021, Passport, Populus and ViaNova. New annual revenues were \$70k, only -\$10k below the estimated target of \$80k. The remaining Rockefeller Grant funds of \$40k were dispersed in June 2021.

The Employee Retention Credit Act of 2021 offset payroll costs by \$63,000. Other expenses such as travel and events were under budget due to continued COVID restrictions.

Work continued with the OMF Trademark submission and the official US registration certificate was received on January 11th, 2022. OMF also retained legal counsel to create

detailed guidance using MDS in the context of GDPR. The Mobility Data Specification MDS v1.2.0 and was released in November 2021.

Despite the many challenges, OMF ended the year \$67k ahead of the anticipated deficit of -\$182k however still ending the year with a deficit of -\$115k.

As of 12/31/2021, the Accounts Receivable balance was \$33,500, details are attached. The Accounts Payable balance was \$749.05, details attached.

Cash on hand was \$267K, with 5.7 months of operating cash. Cash vs. Deferred Liability at 152% above the 100% minimum target.
