February expenses are under budget, primarily due to recruiting costs associated with hiring a new executive director. Those funds have been deferred to the following month.

 $Cash\ on\ hand\ was\ \$525,\!738,\ with\ 3.5\ months\ of\ operating\ cash.\ Cash\ vs.\ Deferred\ Liability\ is\ 169\%\ above\ the\ 100\%\ minimum\ target.$
