Michael R queries whether the 3rd usecase example does what it claims to do - it applies the policySet to potentially other bindings other than binding.ws.

Ashok agrees that there is a problem

One possible solution is to repeat the binding lower in the infoSet. Another alternative is to have the portType as a child of the binding - results in policySets appearing in multiple places in the final result.

Ashok asks the question as to whether the binding and portType elements should be modified to more closely reflect their place in the WSDL schema - ie should binding and interface be peer elements?

Anish: we have to be careful about the distinction between wsdl 1.1 and wsdl 2.0 wrt bindings. WSDL 2.0 bindings can be independent of the interface (portType)

Comparison of these approaches with WSDL 1.1 - noted that it differs for WSDL 2.0

Ashok asks for which approach should we look at to make progress. Following was decided:

To create the infoSet, for the <interface> elements that are siblings of <binding> elements copy them as children of each binding element. In the copied interface only the contents of the portType are included.

Michael R - this is covering the "pull" usecase - where Issue 15 deals with the "push" usecase. The idea is that @appliesTo could be used for some of the complex usecases for which the "push" mechanism is intended.

Dave Booz: there is also a presumption that the push model might override or ignore intents that might be present.
