Dave B reviews the new slides

Debate about the difference between 1a and 1b - as to which is possible/preferred.

Ashok: For interactions, there is matching done between the two ends of a wire. There is also the question of what happens when WS-Policy intersection takes place, since WS-Policy does not have the "Can't do X" type of capability

Dave: Need to consider Part 2 before thinking about that further.

Dave describes Part 2: (Slide 8)

Anish: btw, the "cheap solution" on slide 8 is what .net does wrt policy alternatives

Ashok: What is spelled out on Slide 8 is what Microsoft recommends

- and this can be a reasonable approach since the policy intersection will get the right policies that the client requires

Slide 9 introduces the "optionallyProvides" attribute for a policySet and the "options" attribute for a <service/>.

Mike E: Reasonably happy to have service-side policySets with optionallyProvides but can't see how it would apply to a <reference/>

Ashok: Why you might want optionality on <reference/> - if I build a general purpose client, that can work with a set of services that work with a whole set of services then there is a need to have options for all the policies that the client might need to use with any particular service

Ashok: I'd like to see detail on how Wire validation would work with these capabilities in place

Next steps - I'll email Sanjay indicating that we will discuss this proposal next week
