ASC (administrative)

- We have recently pruned the TC voting membership and will do so again after this meeting
- It appears that we need to have some regular meetings of the code list team in order to work out the adjunct schema proposal
 - Meeting schedule: 8 a.m. Thursdays starting 14 August
 - Use LC mail list, mark messages with [code] slug
 - We will invite other members of the TC to participate and then formally constitute the team
- The LCSC QA/packaging team will start meeting again (Fridays at the usual time: 8 a.m. California time starting 15 August)
- Post-beta-release:
 - LC will process implementer input and issue patches
 - Anne Hendry will capture answers and write a FAQ



UBL status

1. Naming and Design Rules

- Near completion; we are reordering and restructuring the NDR document for accuracy, readability, and consistency
- Release as candidate UBL TC committee specification expected in conjunction with release of UBL 1.0 beta
- The NDR document is accompanied by a separate proposal for distributed code list publication

2. Basic business documents (order, invoice, etc.) and library of reusable data components

- Release of UBL 1.0 Beta expected in late October; will include normative schemas, data models, UML class diagrams, ASN.1 binding, formatting specifications, example instances, etc.

3. Context Methodology

- Extension guidelines are in preparation
- Automatic CM belongs to a second phase of the effort



UBL 1.0 Timeline

- August 2003: Draft 1.0 models, start building skeleton package
- September 2003: Finalize 1.0 models and produce 1.0 beta schemas
- October 2003: Create documentation, sample instances, formatting specifications, ASN.1 specifications, etc.
- End of October 2003: release UBL 1.0 beta for implementation testing and generate publicity around this event
- November 2003: meet to begin work on UBL 2.0 (context methodology, additional data models)
- November 2003 – January 2004: UBL 1.0 beta implementation, beta-to-FCS change logging, UBL 2.0 work
- February 2004 OASIS Board Meeting: submit UBL 1.0 for OASIS standardization



UN/CEFACT report (1)

- Our objective: to create an environment in UN/CEFACT that will allow us to connect with the international business community while maintaining our document-centric focus
- Problem: not everyone in UN/CEFACT agrees with our goals



UN/CEFACT report (2)

- Outcome of meetings held this week:
 - UBL must be the preferred standard syntax for UN/CEFACT XML trade documents intended to be used in lieu of paper, fax, and EDI messages in XML-based trading environments.
 - UN UBL must be instituted under terms of reference that will allow it to continue to evolve its data models and schemas in support of traditional, document-centered commercial practices in partnership with UN/CEFACT members pursuing a process-centric approach.
 - Our plan is to prepare a response to CEFACT stating these points and proposing the creation of a new group, ATG3, with detailed terms of reference for UBL.



LSC: Next TC meeting

- We have been reserving the week of 3-7 November for a meeting in Menlo Park (or San Francisco). Purpose:
 - To maintain momentum and identity
 - To prepare for the beta implementation phase
 - To get started on UBL 2.0
- We recommend adoption of this meeting to the TC
- We suggest a change to the charter that would allow us to meet anywhere; this should be included in pending proposed charter revision



LSC: Future TC meetings

- If we hold a January meeting, we might want to hold it back-to-back with UN/CEFACT ATG in Sydney. Tim has offered to host a meeting in Fremantle.
- If we don't actually meet in January, we can send a delegation (including Tim and others) to represent UBL at the ATG meeting in Sydney.
- As usual, we will be meeting in Europe in the spring. The two most likely venues are
 - A meeting at the UN/CEFACT Forum meeting proposed for 15-19 March in Barcelona
 - A March 2004 meeting in Copenhagen or Walldorf the week before or after the UN/CEFACT Forum meeting in Barcelona
