Organizational Overview

- Reorganization September 2002 to achieve vision for eBusiness over the next 5 years
 - o Provide 'simple, transparent and effective processes for global ecommerce".
 - Exploit information technology advances
 - Adopt new trade facilitation approaches simplification and harmonization of business and governmental processes.
 - Replace e-Business Transition Ad-hoc Working Group (eBTWG)
- Continue top-down approach using open development process
- Released new IPR policy

Operational

- Domain experts: TBG (International Trade and Business Processes Group)
 - Conduct business and governmental process analysis, best practices, and international trade procedures. Includes about 16 current work projects with many more proposed.
- Semantic and information experts: ICG (Information Content Management Group)
 - Manage and define of reusable information blocks retained in a series of libraries (business process catalog, core components library, etc.).
- Technology experts: ATG (Applied Technologies Group)
 - Create trade, business and administration document structures that would be deployed by a specific technology or standard such as UN/EDIFACT or XML.

Support

- Broad modeling and technology experts: TMG (Techniques and Methodologies Group)
 - o Provide base (meta) ICT specifications, recommendations and education.
 - o Function as an ICT research group.
- Legal experts: LG (Legal Group)
 - Issue, publish and present analysis and recommendations regarding legal matters related to UN/CEFACT.





Figure 1 Current UN/CEFACT Organization


Figure 2 – UN/CEFACT Organizational Workflow
